Marmot Library Network, Inc. COUNCIL MEETING May 13-14, 2010 Aspen & Basalt, Colorado MINUTES

Mary Anne Hanson-Wilcox, President, Marmot Library Network, Inc., called the meeting to order at 12:30pm.

1) Mary Anne opened the meeting by summarizing Executive Board accomplishments during the past year. These are reported in the "Marmot Annual Report" (included in the binder for this Council meeting), and restated here:

Last summer the Board employed the accounting firm Dalby, Wendland & Co. to recommend improvements in accounting policies and procedures. Last fall the Marmot Finance Committee issued an RFP and hired DWC to do the 2010 audit. In addition to standard audit services, DWC worked with Marmot to update asset records and other files; Marmot staff trained DWC on the peculiar nature of this nonprofit organization; and DWC trained Marmot staff to improve accounting procedures.

The Finance Committee selected Alpine Bank to manage investments; developed an investment policy so Alpine and Marmot stakeholders could understand Marmot investment needs and goals; and wrote a broader financial policy to clarify roles of the Board and the Director.

The Policy Committee updated the Employee Handbook and Marmot Bylaws with input by the Mountain States Employers Council and the law firm Hoskin, Farina & Kampf. Both documents were approved by this 2010 Council.

Last year it was apparent to many that Marmot prices were out of line with actual costs. In January Jimmy proposed revised "Annual Service Fees", and worked with the Finance Committee to make sure prices reflected actual costs as well as a fair distribution of payments by member libraries. The Board approved the changes in February, but a question of shared memberships in particular, and membership benefits in general, put the price list back on the drawing board for further revisions. The final result was approved in May, and presented at this Council meeting.

2) Amelia invited members to present a 3-minute soapbox speed pitch as a way to gather new priorities for the coming year. Proposals were posted around the room, and attendees voted sticky dots color-coded by library type. A summary of the discussion was given later in the meeting. Here are the results:
